A work plan entitled Clay Pits Investigation Colorado School of Mines Research Institute dated November 10, 2006 was hand delivered to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (the Department) on November 14, 2006. The work plan was submitted by the S. M. Stoller Corporation on behalf of the Colorado School of Mines Research Institute (CSMRI). This work plan has been reviewed.
