Re: RML 617-01 – April 27, 2004 E-mail regarding Soils Classification for the Colorado School of Mines Research Institute (CSMRI) Creekside Site.

Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division staff have reviewed the CSMRI soil classification proposal in the above referenced e-mail to use gamma surveys on the outside of the sacks and composite material samples obtained from the sacks to determine disposal. If the levels meet the disposal cutoff values described in CDPHE's February 26, 2004 letter, then those bags would be disposed at the Waste Management CSI landfill.

Staff has reviewed this proposal and has determined that the impacted materials classified as Class 1 should be disposed as previously discussed and proposed. Determination of the class of impacted material must be determined in-situ, before placing the material in the sacks.
