Subject: Waste Management Options

I just spoke with Alan Scheere, who is Waste Management's person in charge of the TENORM issues. Mr. Scheere said that the current plan is for the Midway landfill to take materials with the following maximum concentrations:

Ra-226+228: 10 pCi/g
U: 100 pCi/g
Th: 55 pCi/g

These concentrations are in keeping (mostly) with the CDPHE Final Guidance document tiering system for an approved MSW landfill (the Thorium concentration is closer to the threshold for the industrial landfill tier).

Waste Management is revising its Waste Identification Plan in conjunction with CDPHE staff to allow acceptance of this kind of material. Once the WIP is accepted by CDPHE, County approval will not be necessary, according to Mr. Scheere. Mr. Scheere anticipates submitting the WIP to CDPHE for approval by the end of April.
