Subject: Waste Management Landfill Options

I just spoke with Bill Jeffry, in-house attorney for Waste Management, which owns CSI and the Midway landfill located south of Colorado Springs in El Paso County. Mr. Jeffry confirmed that Adams County will not allow CSI to accept the types of contaminated soils from the CSMRI Site due to the lawsuit between Adams County and Clean Harbors. Mr. Jeffry said that Waste Management is expecting approval from the State by the end of this month to take this type of material at the Midway landfill. Currently, Midway is not authorized to accept this kind of material. Mr. Jeffry was going to call one of his technical people to ask him to call me to give me more information about the Midway landfill options and availability. Mr. Jeffry said the DADS landfill and other Waste Management landfills in the Denver area are not an option for the CSMRI waste.
